Last week-end in the crowded arena of Düsseldorf stood the Race Of Champions. Fun both for spectators and drivers is the key word of the whole event. What better than a World Touring RACECAR to offer such fun? The world best drivers battled on board. Flash back on the event...

In the Legends ROC, Marc Duez, Stig Blomqvist, Heinz-Harald Frentzen and Hans-Joachim Stuck, whose son Johannes raced in the 2010 RACECAR Series event in Nürburgring, shared the wheel.

In front of their own national audience, Schumacher and Vettel won once again the Nations Cup when Sebastien Ogier, for his 1<sup>st</sup> participation, wins the Race Of Champions.
